



Tours Policies and Protocols

Vehicle Cleaning & Disinfectant Procedures:

- All tour vehicles are thoroughly cleaned and sanitized between tours.
- We will be using a spray disinfectant that has a Drug Identification Number (DIN) and follow product label for dilutions and, contact time required to be effective and safe use
- Tour vehicles will be equipped with hand sanitizer and Lysol wipes for guide and guest use.

General

- Masks are MANDATORY for guests and tour guides while in the tour vehicle and while inside a winery, brewery, or other public commercial establishment (when not tasting/sampling). Masks can be provided to groups if we are notified in advance of the tour date (no fee). Tour guides will have a few extra masks on-hand for guests if needed.
- We are no longer providing bottled water for our tour guests. We highly recommend guests bring their own water for the tour.
- A COVID-19 related questionnaire is required to be filled out and signed at the start of the tour.
- If guests could have been exposed to COVID-19 or are experiencing symptoms, we ask that they refrain from joining the tour or the tour guide is permitted to refuse guests for these reasons if they see fit.
- If you or any member in your group have outside of Canada (by air or otherwise) in the last 2 weeks, then you will not be permitted to join the tour.
- A maximum of 8 people will be permitted in a tour vehicle to comply with group size restrictions.
- All tours are open, multiple groups may be on the same tour (up to a max of 8).
- Private tours are available by request pending availability and are subject to a surcharge based on the group size.
- Refrain from sitting in the passenger side of the vehicle beside the guide.
- Maintain social distancing and abide by applicable COVID-19 protocols while at tour stops.
